**CONTRA COSTA PERFORMING ARTS SOCIETY – STUDENT CHAPTER
WAIVER AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT**

The Contra Costa Performing Arts Society (hereafter referred to as “CCPAS”) is a non-profit public benefit corporation to promote the performing arts among its members and its community.

(Student’s name) _____ has the permission of the undersigned to participate in the CCPAS Student Chapter and its activities. I/We understand and represent that:

1. My/Our child may attend Student Chapter meetings which may be held in public and private venues. Parent(s) are welcome to attend the meetings and field trips with their child. However, if my/our child attends unaccompanied by me/us, I/we as the parent(s) assume full responsibility for the actions of, including but not limited to physical and personal damages caused by a child.
2. The Student Chapter meetings may be held in private homes. While there may be adult supervision at times, the CCPAS does not warrant that a supervising adult will be present every time. I/We agree to allow my child to attend such meetings and to indemnify and hold harmless CCPAS, the Host of the meeting, the owner of the home, the Board, the members, and volunteers from any and all claims or injuries resulting from the meeting.
3. The CCPAS Student Chapter may hold field trips and may arrange transportation to venues for children, including my child.
4. There are risks inherent in driving, including but not limited to, inclement weather producing dangerous road conditions and accidents. All designated drivers will be adults and over the age 21.
5. I/We voluntarily agree to allow my child to ride in the vehicle of the designated driver and assume the entire risk of my child riding in the vehicle of the designated driver, including but not limited to personal injury, including death, which might be suffered if there is an accident. In such an event, I/we agree to indemnify and hold harmless CCPAS, the Driver, the CCPAS Board, its members and volunteers, even if such claims results from negligence in the driving, repair, or maintenance of the vehicle, or from the vehicle’s design or manufacture.
6. In the event of an emergency affecting the health or welfare of my child, the sponsors, leaders, or adult chaperones have permission to administer first aid and/or transport the individual to the nearest doctor or hospital for further medical attention, as deemed necessary. The individual acting in response to the emergency will be held blameless. Any medical expenses occurring will be borne by the participant, or parents/guardians of the participant. The CCPAS carries no medical insurance for its members.
7. If any provision of this waiver and release shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this waiver and release; shall not be affected thereby and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I/We, and each of us, hereby consent to this Waiver and Release from Liability and Indemnity Hold Harmless Agreement as evidenced by our signatures below.

I/We declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
